FAMILY SJ The S J Family lived in mobile home in Boiling Springs that was completely destroyed by the hurricane. There are 3 children, 2 parents. This family needs everything because what wasn't destroyed by water was destroyed by mold. They are desperately looking for a rental mobile home, apartment or house. There are few options at the moment. Basic needs for this family include King or queen bed, pillows, linens, blankets for parents, 3 preferably twin beds, pillows and linens for young people, 4 dressers or chests, Bedside tables, Table and chairs (seats 5), Couch, loveseat or side chairs, Recliner, End tables, lamps, Towels, wash cloths, bath mats, Kitchen linens, potholders, Dishes, glasses, silverware, Pots and pans, baking sheet, muffin pan, Other kitchen items (ie coffee pot, can opener, toaster, cooking utensils, knives etc.), Dish soap, bath soap, cleaning supplies.

Since we did not have our yard sale this November due to the storm we thought we would turn that into a response to our Lord to help those in need. Our teams are now working on the methods to identify the needs, identify the available donations, match them, and communicate to you. We will also be looking for needed resources to support our effort (i.e. transportation, volunteers, etc). Our focus will be on those basic household and human needs. You will see more from us in the near future as we give substance to **Operation Brotherhood**. If you feel called to be an active part of this mission, please let Chap or the church know.
